STUDENTS

This was a really fun event to help with last year. **Our hope is that every student 12 and up will help in some way to make the banquet a memorable evening for those attending and those helping. Please sign up at the information table** for the areas you would like to volunteer to help. There will be blocks of time on Friday, Mar. 18 and all day Sat., Mar. 19. Be sure to check your Friday schedule before signing up and check to see where you need to be in order to help (Asbury or Aldersgate Methodist Church).

Most high school classes will be performing at this event, find out from your director if your class is performing. If you are a performer, you can also sign up to help with decorations, set up, food preparation, and clean up. Much of this will be done on Friday, Mar. 18 and on Sat. morning of the banquet.

If you are 12 or older and NOT performing, you can sign up to serve dinner. We need at least 30 servers. Servers will wear black and white and be provided a black apron. There will be a short training class for you on Sat. before the banquet in order to walk you through the process of serving and assign you your table or station. If you are serving, you can also help with decorations, set up, food preparation, and clean up.

Tickets:

Students can pick up and check out tickets from Tracy Yohn. Return the paid ticket stub and money to her by Friday, Mar. 4. **Please make checks out to: Tracy Yohn.** If you take tickets that you don't need, please turn them in promptly for someone else to use. There is limited seating and someone else may need your tickets.

On the ticket: Be sure an entrée choice is circled.

If someone reserves a table: Bring all the ticket stubs and money for the reserved table to Tracy Yohn at the same time. They will allow guests to sit with other guests of their choice. Open seating will still be available.
