- All choir students will be performing the first song of Psalm 150. Singers Choir and Mezzo Choir students can be dismissed after the first song or stay to listen to the rest of the concert. Please discuss with your family, what your plans are after they are done singing Psalm 150.
- Classes that are performing: Singers/Mezzo Choir students for the first song only, Beethoven, Brahms, Harp Ensemble, Concert Choir, Bel Canto, Classical Guitar, Adoration Band, Jazz Band, Flute Ensemble, Praise and Worship and Percussion Ensemble, as well as the combined songs at the beginning and end.
- Warm-Up rooms and times are listed below. Arrive 15" before your warm-up time.
- All students will be seated in the Worship Center during the Concert.
- Please wear your black concert dress for high school girls, black pants and white or black shirts for boys with their **black bow ties**.
- Plan to bring a snack or your dinner with you, as many of you will be there from 4:30 to 8:30 and please use the Fellowship Hall to eat which is also the band case area.
- Bring all of your music and instrumentalists bring your music stands with you.
- Put all cases in your assigned rooms, even if you warm-up in the Sanctuary.
- Plan to stay for the whole concert from 6:00-8:30ish to encourage your peers.
- After the concert, please plan to stay to restore the church.
