

## Notes for Week 3, September 20!!!

All students report directly to their rooms for classes now. If in doubt, ask at the Information Table.

Each room at Asbury will have a door sign with the daily schedule for each hour on the door. ON the back of the sign is the picture to restore the room for the clean-up crews.

Your music will be in your classrooms waiting for you! Only about half of the music has arrived. When the music arrives, it will be delivered to their classroom. Most of the choir music has arrived this week!

If you are on a set-up crew, mid-day crew, clean-up crew, etc. report to the Information Table for instructions and to sign in each week.

Teachers, if you have a different setup for your room with chairs, tables, keyboards, etc., put a post it note on the door sign.
