

## Notes for Week 4, September 27!!!

All students report directly to their rooms for classes now. If in doubt, ask at the Information Table.

Each room at Asbury will have a door sign with the daily schedule for each hour on the door. ON the back of the sign is the picture to restore the room for the clean-up crews.

Your music will be in your classrooms waiting for you! Five more boxes of music have arrived and will be delivered to your classes.

If you are on a set-up crew, mid-day crew, clean-up crew, etc. report to the Information Table for instructions and to sign in each week.

Teachers, if you have a different setup for your room with chairs, tables, keyboards, etc., put a post it note on the door sign.

If your child has a conflict with a theory class, we have Independent Theory classes arranged at 4 different times during the day: 10:00, Noon, 12:45, and 2:45. The 10:00 Independent Theory class will meet with the Intro to Concert Choir Theory. For instance, students that are in Bach and Mezzo will need to take their Mezzo theory at 10:00 or at 12:00. Please take advantage of the theory classes option of Independent Theory as this is part of your fees and is the secret to our success when all of the students can read and count music.
